

Closed Facility Report

Report Purpose	Lists congregate care facilities, foster homes, and adoptive homes that closed in the past 3 months for a District/Agency.
Prompts	None
Notes	The only closed facilities that the Data Warehouse maintains information on are those that closed in the past 3 months.

Data Item	Data Definition
Report Date	The date on which the report was run.
Data As Of Date	The latest refresh date of the OCFS Data Warehouse – that is, the last time data was retrieved from CONNECTIONS. Data for this report is refreshed each week.
Facilities Closed During the Three Months Prior To	The latest refresh date of the OCFS Data Warehouse.
Worker Agency	The 3-digit code and agency name of the office to which the worker is 'in' assigned.
Authorizing Agency	The 3-digit code and name of the agency that owns the resource.
Total Closed Facilities	Total number of out-of-home settings that closed in the past 3 months.
Office	The name of the office to which the worker is assigned.
Unit	The 3-digit code identifying the unit in which the worker is currently active.
Worker Name	The full name of the worker assigned to the resource.
Resource ID	The CONNECTIONS identification number for the facility.
Home Name	The name by which the facility is known.
Setting	The type of setting for the facility. Values include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foster Home • Adoptive • Congregate
Home Status	The current status of the facility. Values include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closed
Home Closed Date	The date on which the facility was closed.
Certification Date	The date on which the facility was last authorized.

Data Item	Data Definition
Recert Date	The date by which the home needs to be recertified. This information is blank for congregate care facilities.
Closure Reason	<p>The reason the facility was closed.
