#2 A, B, C – Limitations should read as “Applicants is being added effective 4/1/22.”

#4 A – Limitations should read as “Incapacity must be verified by a medical professional at the onset of the disability and at the end of the expected duration of the diagnosis and/or recertification. Applies to both applicants and recipients of child care subsidy and/or Temporary Assistance. Applicants is being added effective 4/1/22.”

#5 – Need to check the ‘No’ box.
